

## jobPath Training for Educators

### Overview:

jobPath is an award-winning, internationally recognized, curriculum based employment discovery tool designed for students who have intellectual disabilities.

This course will provide educators with the tools, background and context to deliver jobPath sessions and help students prepare for successful transitions from school to work.

jobPath focuses on critical self discovery and evaluation of skills and job preferences with modules on:

- Self-Awareness
- Career Exploration
- Life Management
- Hard and Soft Skills
- Health and Safety
- On and off the job supports
- How to keep your job

The job path curriculum will help your students to discover their employable skills and to view themselves in the world of work and begin to map out a career path.

### Learning objectives:

- Understanding the importance of an 'Employment 1st' approach to supporting students who have a disability
- The importance of starting early, raising expectations, and the factors that contribute to successful labour market attachment for students who have disabilities
- Learn who and how to engage with critical stakeholders in communities to ensure successful school to work transitions.
- Learn how the jobPath process is designed to assist participants through person-centered planning process to identify workplace skills, preferences, and interests.
- Review of jobPath toolkit materials, online resources, and activities

### Audience:

This training is designed for anyone who works with students who have a disability. Teachers, Educational Assistants, Coordinators and Principals. It is beneficial to have representation from each level and all team members present at the training.

**Length of training:**

1/2 Day – the training is delivered over 3 hours and includes a 15 minute break
